### **How secure is Mediadisk 2006**

Mediadisk 2006 uses the latest security and data encryption available from Microsoft in the form of Microsoft Web Services Enhancements version 2.0 (WSE 2.0). This means that every time a Web service is called from within Mediadisk 2006, your unique user ID and password are encrypted and sent to the Web Service. This ensures that only authorised users of Mediadisk 2006 are allowed to access the Web Services.

When your data is transferred to or received from a Web Service, it is encrypted within an XML document and transferred over HTTP using Simple Object Access Protocol (SOAP). This is the standard security procedure, which is recommended by Microsoft for secure Web Service access.

Your data is of paramount importance to us and the security and encryption techniques we have used will keep your data safe from unauthorised access while it is held in our database and also when it is being transferred over the Internet.
